- meet regularly with a mentor for personal and professional support
- be a positive role model for all who may come into contact with them through the REMAR program.

The opportunity to be involved in school Solidarity Camps, immersion experiences and theological study may also be available.

WHO CAN APPLY: Any young adult (17+) who has completed the REMAR program.

HOW LONG IS THE COMMITMENT:

Ideally, January 2009 until January 2010. GAPS will receive eight weeks holiday during the year. We are open to considering a six month commitment (January 2009 to June 2009), please feel free to discuss this with us.
